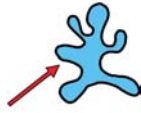


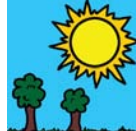
Hanukkah Social Story

 say "thank you"  for  my  gift. My  grandparents








may  give  me  money. They  say  the  name of the










 money is  gelt. I  will  say "thank you"  to my

 The children may  play  the Dreidel  game. There

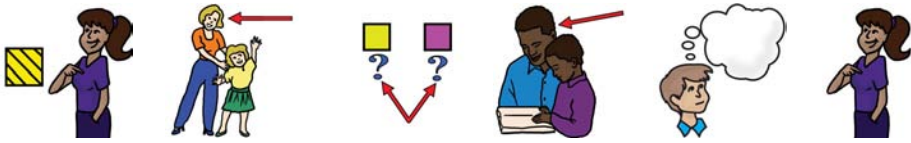
will  be  lots of  laughing  and  excitement. I  will

 that  we  use  in  the  game. I  know  I  will



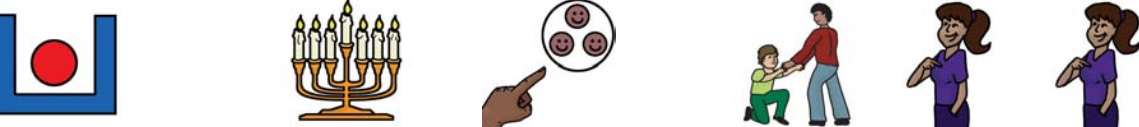
have some chocolate coins when the game is over.
