

# Read and Tell • Aligns with National and State Standards

Standard	How <b>Read and Tell</b> aligns
<b>Students read a variety of literature.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read and Tell--Primary allows children to retell popular picture books which they have read, or which have been read to them.</li><li>• Retelling a story moves learning into long-term memory.</li><li>• Read and Tell--Intermediate and Read and Tell--Teen include chapter summaries adapted in Picture It allowing students struggling with reading access to age-appropriate literature.</li><li>• Fantasy, classics, historical fiction, and nonfiction texts are included.</li><li>• Exposure to many types of stories help students understand the diversity of society and culture.</li></ul>
<b>Students read age-appropriate literature.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read and Tell--Intermediate and Read and Tell--Teen consist of adapted chapters, comprehension materials, and vocabulary lists which enable a student with low reading levels to participate in and learn from regular education literature instruction.</li><li>• The chapter summaries were written at a high interest level using age-appropriate vocabulary.</li><li>• Books included are Newbery Award Winners, classics, and multicultural stories which appeal to students.</li></ul>
<b>Students improve comprehension skills.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Multiple-choice questions relate to the chapter summaries.</li><li>• Inferential and higher-level thinking and problem-solving questions are answered using PixWriter vocabulary setups.</li><li>• Rereading is encouraged to help comprehension.</li><li>• Vocabulary flashcards and definitions can be used in games and drills.</li><li>• When the buttons are selected, and the word is spoken, students can check the meaning of unknown words.</li></ul>
